PROJECT SCHEDULE AND PROGRESS

The PhiloJeunes-Parliamentaires project is part of the activities of the Centre International PhiloJeunes, whose aim is to develop activities to educate young people in democratic and civic values through philosophical dialogue, and to foster the development of critical thinking and civic engagement.

The aim of the project is to create opportunities for young people aged 15 to 17 to express their views on major social issues, which will then be taken to parliamentary bodies.

MEANS

- Set up PhiloJeunes workshops to encourage discussion and reflection among young people on current social issues;
- Present a document summarizing the reflections and any recommendations to the parliamentarians involved in the project.

PROGRAM

Each teacher implements Democratic and Philosophical Discussion (DVDP) workshops on the broad theme of CITIZENSHIP and NATIONALITY, broken down into weekly workshops (work sequences). The pedagogical material, comprising a pedagogical sheet on Citizenship and Nationality, as well as sequence sheets, is available to teachers on the Project's GOOGLE DRIVE. In addition, reference documents are available for a better understanding of the democratic institutions and values of Quebec, Canada, France and the European Union.

The workshops will be synchronized with all the classes in Quebec, Toronto and France to ensure cohesion during the meetings of the PhiloJeunes Parliamentarians ambassadors.

THE ROLE OF AMBASSADORS PHILOJEUNES-PARLEMENTARIANS

Each class will appoint a class representative who will be responsible for bringing the class discussion summaries to the meetings of the PhiloJeunes-Parlementaires young ambassadors.

1- Young ambassadors will meet on the ZOOM platform in the presence of members of the Coordination Committee and elected officials. During these meetings, the young people will discuss, within the framework of a discussion with a democratic and philosophical aim (DVDP), the guiding ideas of their classes in connection with the theme of the meeting.

At each meeting, time is also set aside for an exchange with elected representatives on the theme of the meeting and parliamentary work.

2- The young ambassadors will be asked to reflect on their recommendations and present them to the Project's elected representatives in the form of a document.
